Pixar Internships - Paid

Pixar offers internships in Animation, Technical Direction, Production Management, Story, Marketing, Engineering and Editorial. Students interested in a Technical Director Internship must be currently in college working towards a Bachelors, Masters or PhD Degree and returning to school following their internship at Pixar. For all other internship opportunities, students must be in or have completed at least their junior year of college, be a graduate student, or have graduated the year the internship commences. International students who are able to show work eligibility in the U.S. can apply. Pixar does not provide internship opportunities for high school students.

How to Apply:

An application that requires a demo reel submission has 5 parts:

- the cover letter
- the resume
- the demo reel
- the demo reel breakdown
- the on-line application (the application contains the Reel Submission Agreement)

The cover letter can (and should) be brief. The resume should tell where you've worked, what you did when you worked, what kind of coursework you've had, and what tools, languages, and systems you can use. The demo reel breakdown is really essential. Don't force us to look at a website - when we're looking at reels, we're all greased and ready to go with reels, not websites. (We will look at websites if we're hiring you as a web designer.) Your reel should be no more than 4 minutes.
